COMMUNITY SERVICE GRANT PROGRAM

“Community is what we make it”

In keeping with the mission of the Maize Lions Club, which is to encourage and empower volunteers to serve their communities, we are pleased to announce the establishment of a Community Service Grant Program.

This program offers non-profit organizations the opportunity to earn a grant sponsored by the Maize Lions Club. Every non-profit organization that applies will be considered, however, those within the City of Maize and / or USD266 will be given first priority. Organizations that are selected will have an opportunity to earn a grant in exchange for providing community service.

Grant eligibility and fulfillment requirements:

1. Volunteer service for a community event designated by the Lions Club.
 - The organization must be non-profit and have a minimum of 5 volunteers.
 - Volunteers must be at least 14 years of age.
 - The organization must agree to donate a minimum of 20 hours of community service in 4 hour shifts. Examples:
 - 5 people at 4 hour slots = 20 hours community service and a \$160 grant
 - 10 people at 4 hour slots = 40 hours community service and a \$320 grant.

2. The Lions Club will assign duties, dates, and times for volunteers to work.
 - The organization is responsible for scheduling their volunteers to work.
 - Volunteers must check-in and check-out with the Lions Club.
 - The organization is responsible for tracking and reporting hours worked. Reported hours are subject to the review and approval of the Lions Club.
 - The Lions Club reserves the right to dismiss anyone who is not being productive, or not demonstrating appropriate work ethics.
 - If a volunteer is dismissed, late, or does not show for the event, and the organization does not find someone to replace that volunteer, the organization will forfeit that person's portion of the grant.
 - No funds will be awarded until all service hours have been completed.

3. The organization must fill out and return the attached grant application.
 - Notification of our decision will be made via email or letter within 6 weeks from date of receipt.
